

COLLARS - BASIC INSTRUCTIONS

*All values are given in cm.

Instruction

The instructions for these collars are basic instructions. You can change the size and look of the collar, stand, and overlap as needed. Note however that the collar should be 1.5 cm wider than the collar stand. The overlap has to be the same as the overlap at the model you want to construct.

1. Two-piece collar

Start by drawing a right angle which is CB and the bottom line of the stand. Mark the value of the point 1/2 NC (1/2 neck circumference, see figure 4) on the horizontal line. From there, place a perpendicular guide line on 2 cm. Mark the width of the stand, 3 cm on CB and 2.5 cm on CF, and draw the stand as shown in figure 1.

- Note that the overlap of the stand has to be the same as the overlap on the model, here 1.5 cm.

From the top of the stand, draw a guide line perpendicular to the CB-line. Measure 1.5 cm upwards from there and then further upwards; mark the width of the collar CB. Finish the collar as shown in figure 1.

2. One-piece collar

Start by drawing a right angle which is CB and the bottom line of the stand. Mark the value for the point 1/2 NC (1/2 neck circumference, see figure 4) on the horizontal line. Measure 2 cm upwards and mark the width of the stand, 3 cm on CB and 2.5 cm on CF, and draw the stand as shown in figure 2.

- Note that the overlap of the stand has to be the same as the overlap on the model, here 1.5 cm. From the stand mark the width of the collar on the CB-line. Draw the rest of the collar as shown in figure 2.

3. Mandarin collar

Start by drawing a right angle which is CB and the bottom line of the collar. Mark the value for the point 1/2 NC (1/2 neck circumference, see figure 4) on the horizontal line. From there, place a perpendicular guide line on 2 cm. Mark the width of the collar, 3 cm on CB and CF, and finish the collar as shown in figure 3.
